CAP/Marketing Board Meeting Scheduled

NORTH LITTLE ROCK—The Arkansas State Marketing Board for Recyclables and Compliance Advisory Panel (CAP) will conduct its third quarterly meeting on Monday, September 30, 2019, in Eureka Springs. Members will meet at the Best Western Inn of the Ozarks in the Dogwood Room, 207 W. Van Buren, Eureka Springs, Arkansas. This meeting is scheduled to coincide with the Arkansas Recycling Coalition annual conference. The board meeting is scheduled prior to the conference reception from 3:00 p.m.—4:30 p.m.

CAP's newly elected chairman, Jay Saxton, will lead the group in a discussion on outreach and planning opportunities for 2020. Jay Saxton has been the General Manager of Natural State Recycling since 2015. He entered the recycling business in 2011 after spending over ten years in agriculture related positions.

The Sustainability Consortium will be discussing their partnership with the Northwest Arkansas Council to develop a roadmap for economic development in the region based on the circular movement of recycled and recovered materials. The Department of Energy and Environment, Division of Environmental Quality (DEQ) will give the Marketing Board an update on the status of the Public Notice Task Force and discuss how changes to the public notice system might affect small businesses.

The Marketing Board advises and assists DEQ with finding and maintaining markets for recyclable materials in Arkansas. CAP is a federal program that was established to help small businesses with its air permits.
