Ripple Glass is providing Owens Corning with recycled glass to use in their manufacturing process for fiberglass and Verallia, to make new glass bottles.

Ripple has expanded their collection of glass into Arkansas. They are willing to provide transportation from any location in Arkansas to collect full truckloads of recycled mixed glass (approximately 23 tons of glass). They prefer that the glass not be crushed, but are willing to work with you.
